Abstract - S.E.R. Foundation's proposals:

S.E.R. Foundation proposes a **Reconciliation Code of Ethics** to eradicate extreme poverty. The idea is that everybody, who has enough, shares his wealth with those, who need help.

Reconciliation as a way for **sharing** demands new structures and a change of paradigm in economics to uplift human dignity: The **one** hundred richest companies or private men in every country should invest a certain percentage of their fortune in educational and climate change programs.

Sharing as an indispensable virtue is shown by an art contribution: **St. Martin** – a bronce statue.

The **Teatro la Luna project**, founded in 1984 in Cordoba, Argentina, shows that **Education is the starting point to diminish poverty**. The aim is to teach street-children artistic skills that will enable them to develop a professional perspective for life and to get soup and bread.

S.E.R. Foundation proposed to the UN General Assembly the creation of a **UN NGO Department** to strengthen the operational effectiveness of the UN and its executive arm in the grass-roots level.

It also created a global **Reconciliation Year Plan 2009** to inform civil society about the purpose of the UN General Assembly proclamation of **2009 International Reconciliation Year**.
